Solving percent problems is as easy as learning four vocabulary words and phrases:

$$
\begin{aligned}
\text { What number } & \rightarrow x \text { (or another variable) } \\
\text { of } & \rightarrow \text { times } \\
\text { is } & \rightarrow \text { equals } \\
\text { percent } & \rightarrow \overline{100}
\end{aligned}
$$

Study the examples below to see how these words and phrases help to solve percent problems.

30 is what percent of 80

$$
\frac{30}{1}=\frac{x}{100} \times \frac{80}{1}
$$

$15 \%$ of what number is 60

$$
\frac{30}{100} \times \frac{x}{1}=\frac{60}{1}
$$

What percent of 120 is 75

$$
\frac{x}{100} \times \frac{120}{1}=\frac{75}{1}
$$
